Damage Prevention Professional

The Public Education and Damage Prevention Committee (PEDPC) is a volunteer over site committee that works with Oklahoma One Call (Call Okie) in the education, marketing and communication of the call before you dig message. An additional role for the PEDPC is the Oklahoma Regional Partner Common Ground Alliance (OKCGA).

Clearly the amount of effort performed by damage prevention stakeholders is focused on safety and protection of our underground infrastructure. These damage prevention professionals can be designated by their employers in a damage prevention role or can act voluntarily. The goal of the Oklahoma Damage Prevention Professional to recognize these individuals to their management team.

Oklahoma is also very lucky to have many excavators focused on safety and facility protection. The Damage Prevention Professional recognition program will be expanded to include these individuals and companies.

Candidates apply for period of one year from application date and earlier using the Damage Prevention Professional Form. (Recognitions for the plan year 2012 are retroactive from 8-11-2011). The candidate will self-score. The candidate must provide evidence of participation to the OKCGA committee. All applications must have been submitted by July to Call Okie Damage Prevention Department to be presented at the next PEDPC meeting.
